1803 – 1817

Scope and Content

Hannah Burton was born May 25, 1776, the daughter of John and Lydia Wolfe of Lewes and Rehoboth Hundred. She married Joshua Burton on August 29, 1794, at Lewes and Coolspring Presbyterian Church.

Burton's diary is not a typical depiction of her daily activities, but more a record of church related activities. Typical entries contain references to Bible verses and hymns used in church and funeral services. Some entries contain the name of the pastor performing the service as well as the church where the service was performed. The diary also contains references to baptisms, marriages, and deaths, which have been abstracted and placed in our card file indices.
